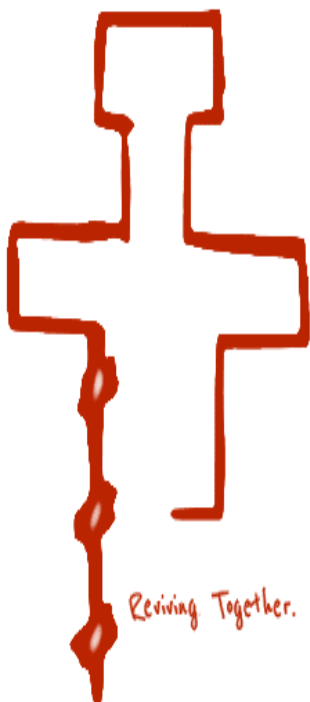

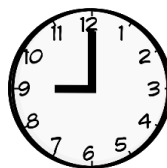

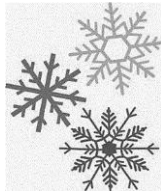
2023 MASS BOOK INFORMATION

Deacon's Corner

The memorial of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Monday, November 21. The celebration of this feast dates back to the 6th century with the dedication of the New Church of Saint Mary, the Mother of God which was built by the Emperor Justinian I near the ruins of the temple in Jerusalem.

This date of the feast day was adopted by the universal Church in the sixteenth century. It commemorates the tradition that explains that Mary was taken by her parents, Anne and Joachim to the temple in Jerusalem when she was 3 years old and was dedicated to God. This dedication was done in thanksgiving to fulfill a promise made to God when Anne was childless.

God chose to dwell in Mary in a special way as she gave herself freely to the service of the Lord. It prepared Mary and ultimately led to the Immaculate Conception where she accepted Our Lord's offer to become the Mother of God. Mary responded with the words, "Let it be done to me according to your word."

By our Baptism, we are called to be disciples of Christ in loving God and our neighbors. Like our Blessed Mother, the Mother of God and the first disciple of Christ, may we make a commitment in our lives to do the will of our Heavenly Father.
