

## **DEACON'S CORNER**

This week, we celebrate two solemnities: the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi Sunday, on June 11 and the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, June 16. The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ originated in the 12<sup>th</sup> century and was adopted by the whole Church in 1264 by Pope Urban IV.

Corpus Christi Sunday focuses our faith on the Holy Eucharist as the real and living presence of Jesus Christ. On this Sunday, in St. John's Gospel, Jesus says to the crowds and each of us: "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life . . ." (John <u>6:51-58</u>).

On Friday, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated. In 1856, Pope Pius IX established this feast for the whole Church, to be celebrated on the Friday after Corpus Christi. St. Bonaventure's work, "With You is the Source of Life" points to the Sacred Heart as the fountain from which God's love pours into our lives. In the Gospel on this day, Jesus assures us of His overflowing love, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest ... for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves" (Matthew 11:25-30).
