#### **Deacon's Corner**

All Saints Day will be celebrated on Friday, November 1. This holy day honors all the saints, known and unknown, who have entered into eternal life. All Saints Day was instituted by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon in Rome to Virgin Mary and all the martyrs in May 609 AD. The day was moved to November 1 by Pope Gregory III in the 8<sup>th</sup> century and dedicated to all the saints. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops defines saints as "persons in heaven (officially or not), who lived heroically virtuous lives, offered their life for others, or were martyred for the faith, and who are worthy of imitation."

We are all called to be saints. We can accomplish this by striving to follow God's commands and being united with Him in love. On this day, may we pray and ask the saints to pray for us in our lives.
