Deacon's Corner

On Monday, November 4, the Memorial of Saint Charles Borromeo, Bishop, is celebrated. He was born in a wealthy family in Milan, Italy in 1538. Charles desired to devote himself to Church ministry. Pope Pius IV ordained him a cardinal and appointed him as the Administrator of the Archdiocese of Milan. He is credited with keeping the Council of Trent in session when it was on the verge of dissolving. The Council created the Roman Catechism and texts for liturgical works and hymns.

After the Council, St. Charles adopted a simple life style and began to devote time to the people in the Archdiocese of Milan. He adopted a series of reforms for the bishops and clergy, founded many colleges and seminaries for the clergy and gave his wealth and resources to charity to support the poor.

St. Charles Borromeo saw Jesus Christ in his neighbors and believed that charity shown to the least of His flock was mercy done for Our Savior. May we have this same belief and act in concrete ways for people in need in our communities. St. Charles is the patron saint of catechists, catechumens and seminarians.
