Deacon's Corner

The feast of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** will be celebrated on Tuesday, July 16. This name is given to the Blessed Mother as the patroness of the Carmelite order. In the 13th century, Christian hermits settled on Mount Carmel in the Holy Land. They became known as the Carmelites. They constructed a chapel and dedicated it to the Blessed Mother.

According to the Carmelite tradition, the brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel was presented by Our Lady to St. Simon Stock who was the Father General of the Order in 1251. Our Lady gave St. Simon the following promise, "Receive, My beloved son, this habit of thy order: this shall be to thee and to all Carmelites a privilege, that whosoever dies clothed in this shall never suffer eternal fire. It shall be a sign of salvation, a protection in danger and a pledge of peace."

Let us pray the prayer to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. O most beautiful Flower of Mount Carmel, fruitful vine, splendor of heaven, Blessed Mother of the Son of God, Immaculate Virgin, assist me in this my necessity. O Star of the Sea, help me and show me herein that you are my Mother. O Holy Mary, Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and earth, I humbly beseech you from the bottom of my heart, to succor me in this my necessity. There are none that can withstand your power. O show me herein that you are my Mother. O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us that have recourse to thee. (3 times) Sweet Mother, I place this cause in your hands. (3 times)
