Deacon's Corner

The feast day of **St. Matthias, Apostle,** will be celebrated on Tuesday, May 14. Very little is known about St. Matthias. After Judas Iscariot had died, St. Peter recommended that a person be appointed to replace him so that the Apostles would again number twelve.

The Acts of the Apostles tell us that the Apostles and other disciples "proposed two, Joseph called Barsabbas, who was also known as Justus, and Matthias. Then they prayed, 'You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two you have chosen to take the place in this apostolic ministry from which Judas turned away to go to his own place.' Then they gave lots to them, and the lot fell upon Matthias, and he was counted with the eleven apostles" (Acts 1:23-26).

This election of Matthias occurred before Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came to the Twelve Apostles, a united body, and the other disciples. After this selection, there is no other information mentioned about him. Tradition tells us that he traveled and preached in Cappadocia, modern-day Turkey, and then east to the Caspian Sea, in modern-day Georgia. St. Matthias is believed to have died a martyr by crucifixion.

St. Matthias is the patron saint of alcoholics, carpenters and tailors. On his feast day, may we pray, "St. Matthias, pray for me, that I will listen to the voice of God and respond to His call generously all the days of my life."
