

Deacon's Corner

The optional memorial of St. Pope John Paul II will be celebrated on Tuesday, October 22. St. John Paul was born Karol Jozef Wojtyla in 1920 in Wadowice, Poland. After being ordained a priest in Poland, he became an auxiliary bishop. In 1964, he was selected as the Archbishop of Krakow and participated in the Second Vatican Council.

Archbishop Wojtyla was elected pope, the 263rd successor to St. Peter, in October 1978 and took the name John Paul II. He led the initiatives in the creation of the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the Code of Canon Law for the Latin Church and for the Eastern Churches. In the missionary spirit, he met and greeted millions of people in his papal ministry. He also attracted young people to the Church by beginning the celebration of World Youth Day. Pope John Paul II passed on to eternal life on Saturday, April 2, 2005, the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday, which he instituted. He was canonized by Pope Francis on April 17, 2014.
