Deacon's Corner

On Tuesday, August 6, we will celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke describe the Transfiguration with remarkable agreement. Tradition names Mount Tabor as the site of this miraculous occurrence. In the Gospel of St. Mark, we hear, "Jesus took Peter, James and his brother John, and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them . . . Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to him' "(9:2-10).

This event occurs after Peter's profession of faith that Jesus is the Messiah (Luke 9:20). It is our Savior's first revelation of His death and resurrection. St. Thomas Aquinas explains that the Transfiguration occurred because "the divine glory which was Christ's was allowed for a moment to shine through His human body. He did this so that His disciples could taste for a short time the contemplation of eternal joy, in view of the persecutions they would suffer."

The late Archbishop Joseph Raya described the Transfiguration "not simply as an event out of the two-thousand-year-old past, or a future yet to come. It is rather a reality of the present, a way of life available to those who seek and accept Christ's nearness."
