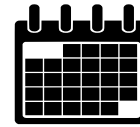

Deacon's Corner

The Feast of Saint Luke, evangelist, will be observed on Friday, October 18. St. Luke is one of the four evangelists who were authors of the Gospels. The early Church Fathers accepted that St. Luke authored the Gospel of St. Luke and the Acts of the Apostles.
St. Luke traveled with St. Paul and evangelized Greece and Rome with him. When Paul is imprisoned and put to death in Rome, it is Luke that stays with him to the end.
St. Luke is the patron saint of artists, doctors, surgeons and bachelors. On his feast day, may we read and pray about a passage in his Gospel and ask God to help us understand its meaning for our lives.
