Deacon's Corner

This week, on Thursday, we will celebrate Thanksgiving Day, a national holiday. During the mass on this day, we hear in the Gospel of St. Luke that Jesus meets and cleanses ten lepers in a village. Christ asks them to go to the priests and "show themselves". Only one of these lepers return to Jesus to thank Him. Our Lord says, "Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine?" Then, Jesus says, to the one man who was healed, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." On this day, let us count our blessings, acknowledge God's love and mercy in our daily lives, and thank Him for His goodness. As Catholics, Thanksgiving Day also has a deeper meaning for us. We need to be thankful for the supreme sacrifice that Christ offered on our behalf on the Holy Cross as He conquered sin and death for each one of us.
