Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI

A leading theologian of the 20th century and the first pope to resign from office in nearly 600 years, passed away at the age of 95 on December 31 in the Ecclesiae Monastery in the Vatican. Pope Benedict the XVI's funeral Mass was held on January 5, 2023 in St. Peter's Square. "May eternal rest be granted unto Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI and may his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace."

Deacon's Corner

The Baptism of the Lord will be celebrated on Monday, January 9. This feast brings an end to the Christmas season. The gospel of St. Matthew describes this event, "After Jesus was baptized by john, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for Him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon Him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased ' "(3:13-17). Jesus chooses to be baptized because He fulfills "all righteousness" allowing Himself to be the perfect sacrifice for our salvation. Jesus proclaims to St. John the Baptist, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness" (Matthew 3: 14-15). As we recall the Lord's baptism, we are reminded of our own baptism. As we were baptized by a priest or a deacon, in love, God proclaims, "This is my beloved son or my beloved daughter with whom I am well pleased." Let us always be thankful to Our Lord who redeems us from our sins and sends Jesus Christ, His only Son, to bring us eternal life. On this day, may we pray, "Heavenly Father, keep us your children born of water and the Spirit faithful to our calling."
