Deacon's Corner Third Week of Advent

The Third Week of Advent begins this Sunday, which is also known as Gaudete Sunday. The Latin word Gaudete means "rejoice" which is the first word in the Mass's Entrance Antiphon. The rose vestments worn by the priest symbolizes the joy that we experience as our Savior's birth approaches. The pink candle, the third candle of the Advent wreath, is called the Shepherd's Candle. It represents the joy we feel at the birth of Christ as well as the joy we have in anticipation of His return.

In the Gospel of St. Luke (3:10-18) this Sunday, the people ask St. John the Baptist what they should do to welcome the Messiah. He advises the people and each one of us to be honest, kind, and charitable with our sisters and brothers. He also encourages us to be just with people in our daily interactions and to serve as an example of faith in our lives so we can help to lead others to Our Savior.

During this week, may we pray, "Lord, may we look forward to the birth of Christ with joy and celebrate this feast with love and thanksgiving. Amen." Let us also pray and reflect about an important spiritual question, "How is Jesus inviting you to experience greater joy this Advent?"

A Biblical Walk Through the Mass

Through the Mass, we encounter God in the most intimate way possible as we hear him speak to us in the Liturgy of the Word and as we receive him Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Holy Eucharist. In his video-based program, *A Biblical Walk Through the Mass*, Dr. Edward Sri explores the roots of the words and gestures we experience at Mass and explains their significance. This study of the Mass will renew your faith and deepen your love for the Holy Eucharist.
