Deacon's Corner The Memorial of the Presentation of the **Blessed Virgin Mary**

The Memorial of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Thursday, November 21. This feast of the presentation dates back to the 15th and 16th centuries. This memorial is based on an ancient tradition that Mary was taken to the temple in Jerusalem by her parents, Anne and Joachim, when she was three years old and dedicated to God. Mary's offering of herself throughout her young life prepared her to become the Mother of God.

Although this memorial has no historical confirmation. it emphasizes that Mary devoted all of her life to God, from the moment of her birth and then the presentation in the temple. The Blessed Virgin Mary was destined in God's plans for the fulfillment of the salvific mission of humanity. On this day, we celebrate that God chose to dwell in Mary in a very special way. Ever since our Baptism, Our Lord also invites us to dedicate ourselves to Him as Our Blessed Mother did in her life.

On this feast day, may we pray, "As we venerate the glorious memory of the most holy Virgin Mary, grant, we pray, O Lord, through her intercession, that we, too, may merit to receive the fullness of your grace. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen."
