#### **DEACON'S CORNER**

Pentecost Sunday

This weekend, we celebrate the feast of Pentecost Sunday. On this day, the Gospel of St. John explains that "the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained'" (John <u>20:19-23</u>).

The feast of Pentecost occurs 50 days after the Resurrection of Our Savior and 10 days after His Ascension into heaven. This feast day concludes the Easter season. This day celebrates the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Blessed Mother, and Jesus' first followers who were gathered in the Upper Room. The Holy Spirit gives the Apostles various gifts to go into the world to preach the Good News.

Inspired by the Holy Spirit, St. Peter preached his first homily proclaiming to the people that Jesus who was crucified is the Lord and was raised from the dead. He encouraged them to repent of their sins and to be baptized. Three thousand people were baptized following his sermon. Given this event, Pentecost is considered the birth of the Church.

Like Jesus' disciples, the Holy Spirit comes to teach and remind each of us to practice the teachings of Jesus Christ in our daily living as Christians. On this day, may we pray, "Come, Holy Spirit, Come."

In an effort to embrace and welcome the members of our church with

Sensory Friendly Mass

Autism, Down Syndrome, and developmental disabilities, Our Lady of

Hope will begin hosting once a month Sensory-Friendly Liturgies. These Masses include lower lights, softer music, and shorter more literal homilies; however, the biggest difference is that we try to create an environment that is welcoming and non judgmental to all. We encourage families and individuals to get up and move if needed, to bring alternative seating, fidgets or noise cancelling headphones and to participate in the liturgy just as they are.

Our first Sensory Friendly Mass will be on July 21, at 2:00 PM with fellowship to follow.
