DEACON'S CORNER

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross will be celebrated on Saturday, September 14. This feast celebrates the salvific impact of the Holy Cross for all of humanity. Pope Francis explains, "Today, the cruelty of the Cross is not what is exalted, but the Love that God manifested to humanity by accepting death on the Cross: "Who, though in the form of God, emptied himself, taking the form of a slave. This is the glory of the Cross of Jesus!" Through His death on the Cross, Jesus destroyed death and opened the gates of heaven to us.

This feast day has been celebrated by the Catholic Church since the seventh century. It also commemorates two major historical events. The first event is the discovery of the True Cross in 326 by Emperor Constantine's mother, Saint Helena, a devout Christian. The second is the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem on September 14, 335 A.D. when the Holy Cross was brought into the church for public veneration.

On this feast day, may we pray, "We adore you, Lord Jesus Christ, here, and in all your churches throughout the whole world, and we bless you, for by your holy cross you have redeemed the world." (Saint Francis of Assisi)



TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 35:4-7a

Isaiah tells the people to be strong and unafraid. God will save his people, and the blind will see, the deaf will hear, and the lame will walk. Streams will come forth in the desert, the sandy ground will become springs of water.

Second Reading: James 2:1-5

James encourages the people to never show favoritism. He discusses an usher who escorted a rich man to the best seat, while ignoring a poor man. God chose poor people to be rich in faith, so we should never judge people by their riches.

Gospel: Mark 7:31-37

Some people brought a deaf man who could not speak to Jesus and begged him to lay his hand on the man. Jesus opened the man's ears and cured his speech impediment. He ordered the people not to tell anyone, but they were too amazed to keep this to themselves.
