Deacon's Corner

On Friday, October 7, we celebrate the memorial of **Our Lady of the Rosary**. This feast was initially established by Saint Pope Pius V in 1573 to thank God for the victory of the Christian navies over the Ottoman Turks at Lepanto. This feast day was extended to the Universal Church in 1716 by Pope Clement XI.

The Holy Rosary is a Scriptural based prayer. St. John Paul II said, the rosary is "a compendium of the Gospel and it's intended to help us grow in our faith as we come to understand more and more about the life, the death, the resurrection and the ascension of Jesus Christ and about the Church and who we are in the Lord."

The Mysteries of the Rosary: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous (which was added by Pope John Paul II in 2002) center on the events of Christ's and His Blessed Mother's lives.

October is designated as "Month of the Holy Rosary".
